



Camp Rules and General Terms & Conditions

We are sure you will have a great time with us at the Whizzkids Discover IT Summer Camp and these rules have been formulated to ensure that a safe and enjoyable experience can be had by all participants. Failure to comply with these rules will warrant immediate disciplinary action which could include expulsion from the camp, in which case, no reimbursement of fees will be made.

1. All Whizzkids attendees must maintain acceptable standards of behaviour both while attending activities and during free time. Attendees must not participate in disruptive or inappropriate behaviour that may interfere with the summer camp or University functions. They are expected to be responsive and respectful to camp staff and their reasonable requests. Similar respect should be shown to all other attendees as well as other personnel working or studying at the University/College.
2. All attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Disregard of personal safety or that of others is grounds for disciplinary action. Any items considered harmful to others will be confiscated immediately. Bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.
3. The Camp Manager should be informed about any medical conditions or for the need to take any medications prior to the commencement of the camp. Any sickness or injury, regardless of seriousness, must be reported to the Camp Manager immediately. All Camp attendees should participate in and follow the planned program. If you are sick or unable to attend a class for any reason, you must inform your instructor or the Camp Manager.
4. Attendees are not permitted to leave the campus without permission & certain areas will remain out of bounds.
5. Whizzkids Summer Camps will operate to the highest safety standards. In consideration of the acceptance of above, the applicant agrees that Whizzkids Summer Camp and / or their employees will not be held responsible for any accidents or loss of personal property, however caused.
6. The use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs is strictly prohibited.
7. Attendees must comply with the Whizzkids Acceptable Internet Usage Policy at all times.
8. Attendees should remain with the group at all times. If a student leaves the group even for a short period (toilet breaks, going to the shop during break times etc) they must inform their camp instructor.
9. Attendees are responsible for their own property. All necessary equipment will be provided by Whizzkids, so attendees are advised not to bring laptops, cameras, etc with them in case of loss/damage. If items are left behind during/after camp, we will do our best to reunite you with your lost property, but cannot be held responsible for loss/damage and we advise attendees to check before they leave to ensure that they have all of their possessions.
10. Whizzkids Summer Camps will not be responsible for any child left unsupervised outside of camp hours.
11. Whizzkids Summer Camps reserves the right to make date/venue changes if necessary.
12. Cancellations made up to 7 days before the camp begins will receive a 90% refund. No refunds will be given for cancellations received less than 7 days before the camp.
